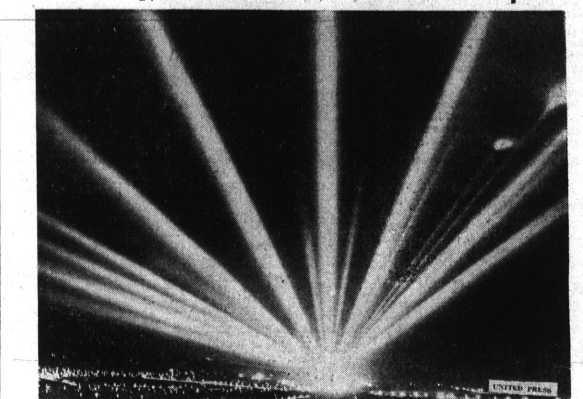

## What Army Did With 25 Billion Candlepower

## Truck Driver Has Artistic Touch, Constructs Match Villages as Hobby

ST. LOUIS (U.P.)—Jerry Jaros, a 25-year-old truck driver, has the soul of an artist, the skill of an architect and great patience.

He builds, not just match houses, but match villages. Some day, if he keeps up his present construction pace, he'll have a complete match city.

Jaros took up match-house making two years ago as a hobby. Since then, in his spare time, he has built four bungalows, a school, church, filling station, saloon, theatre, bank and garage.

His only tools are matches, a razor blade and glue. He does not use paint, but burns and scorches them various shades while they're still in the box.

With artistic detail and sym-

metry, Jaros furnishes his church with three crosses, pews, an altar and a pipe organ. His saloon has a bar, stools and booths. His bank has teller cages.

Jaros' bungalows have shaded "shingled" roofs, window shutters and shades, chimneys, doorsteps, doorknobs, and even a residence number. His school-

house (his most painstaking effort; it required 3,200 matches, while his bungalows average 1,300 and his church took 1,010) has a fence of match "posts" extending all around. One of his bungalows has a garage attached.

The school-house was two months in construction. Jaros' other buildings averaged about a month of his spare time. He got most of his ideas from observation of residences at which he made deliveries.

Jaros figures he'll just go on turning out a building a month—until he runs out of matches.

Ice to Go Into Concrete BERLIN (U.P.)—A new concrete mixing process is being used to build seven new large dams in the Harz Mountains in Germany. The concrete will not be mixed with water but with ice so the temperature will not rise inside the dam wall.
