Newspaper Expert Tells Kiwanians Herald Excels in Its Field

One of the most complete analyses of a newspaper ever made was reported in detail to members and guests of the Torrance Kiwanis club Monday night by Ed Stearns, San Pedro advertising consultant, when he took The Herald and page-by-page commented on the make-up, news content, picture arrangements and advertising.

Stearns' review of this newspaper was most complimentary—so much so that the faces of two staff members who were present, Ray Brooks, advertising manager, and Michael Strasser, city editor, were reddened by embarrassment. His remarks, it can truthfully be reported, took them by surprise as they had no advance information on what he was going to talk about.

Twenty years' experience in newspaper work qualified the San Pedro man to speak as an expert and his study of last week's Herald revealed, he said, that the "care with which your local paper is prepared, edited and printed is most extraordinary. I have never seen a better production and it certainly reflects credit, not only on the staff but on your town."

San Gabriel Areas Closed to Public To Prevent Fires

A section of the San Gabriel mountains including the East Fork of the San Gabriel Canyon, Cattle Canyon, Goldwater Canyon, Iron Fork, Fish Fork, Alder and Mine Gulch, has been closed to public use and travel because of fire hazard.

Permits will be issued only to persons having legitimate business in the area and not for recreational use. They may be obtained at the Glendora city hall. The closed area is adjacent to the San Dimas Experimental Forest, which has been closed for the past several years.

Public cooperation is asked by the Forest Service through observance of the restriction on smoking, closures and fires. No smoking is permitted in the National Forests except at posted areas, campgrounds and places of habitation. For the past five years there have been approximately 4,500 fires each year in California caused by man's carelessness.

State Chamber Doubles Fund Request of Co.

With the board of supervisors trying to cut down next year's budget by at least five percent, county officials received an unexpected jolt Tuesday in a request from the California State Chamber of Commerce asking that its budget be increased 100 percent over last year.

The supervisors last year allowed the state chamber \$16,500 out of exploitation funds, the Los Angeles chamber \$26,250 and the All-Year Club of Southern California \$228,000. The state chamber asked for \$30,000 for next year. The state body got along on \$10,000 in 1936-37 and the increase requested would be 300 percent.

County to Post Weed Notices On Subdivided Land

Notices to destroy weeds in the unincorporated areas of Los Angeles county are to be posted henceforth only on subdivided land, under an amendment to the county weed ordinance adopted by the board of supervisors.

In the past some notices have been posted on land on which farmers were growing weeds as part of the soil conservation program of the federal government, and being paid for growing them.
