With the board of supervisors trying to cut down next year's budget by at least five percent, county officials received an unexpected joit Tuesday in a request from the California State Chamber of Commerce asking that its budget be increased 100 percent over last year.

The supervisors last year allowed the state chamber \$16,500 out of exploitation funds, the Los Angeles chamber \$228,200 and the All-Year Club of Southern California \$228,000. The state chamber asked for \$30,000 for next year. The state body got along on \$10,000 in 1936-37 and the increase requested would be 300 percent.
