FRUIT JUICES ARE DELICIOUS SALAD MOLDS

Women like to entertain their friends at attractive, easy to prepare luncheons during the summer months, and they are always looking for foods that will intrigue the interest and increase the pleasure of the guests. Molded fruit salads offer many possibilities of meeting each one of the mentioned desires.

"Imagination and a pretty chop platter will do wonders for final results with these salads. There are many canned juices that can be used as a base, such as pineapple, grapefruit, cherry, cranberry, loganberry, blackberry, raspberry, plum, peach, pear, and so on, and naturally more flavors can be obtained by mixing two or more juices. Canned fruits may be used, in which case the syrup from the fruit should be used in the gelatin mixture. It might be that the fruits would be served around the mold.

Anyway, prepared flavored gelatin, such as lemon, orange, and lime, blends nicely with the fruit juices, or you may prefer to use the plain gelatin. In either case one package of flavored gelatin, or two tablespoons of plain gelatin should be used to each two cups of juice.

During the summer combine raw fruits with canned fruits. For instance, with a canned fruit juice ring mold, fill the center of the ring with fresh pitted cherries, and around the ring arrange slices of melon, any kind, but choose one that particularly suits the flavors of the juices used. Watermelon with the pineapple or grapefruit, and cantaloupe or honey dew with cherry or berry juices, are suggestions to you.

A mixed fruit salad with a whipped cream dressing might be featured in the center ring mold, and in that case it would make a particularly nice dessert type of salad. "Dessert" luncheons are popular and it would be fine for that kind of entertaining.

Tests Disclose Strange Facts On Whispering

CLEVELAND, O. (U.P.)—Dr. J. O. Perrine, who studies such things, believes that the reason schoolboys aren't often caught whispering is because they don't use the part of the voice which distinguishes one person from another.

"Whisperers can't be recognized on the evidence of sound alone," he said. "If a schoolboy can keep a straight face and not look guilty, he is all set—but you shouldn't tell them that."

To demonstrate, Dr. Perrine used a loud-speaker with four "throats," each of which responded to a different "frequency"—the quality of sound which determines whether it is "high" or "low."

With the high frequency throats turned off, speech or song from phonograph records had a musical quality but was not intelligible.

Eliminating the very highest frequencies alone made a singer lisp. With the low frequencies eliminated, speech was understandable but harsh and unpleasant.

"Few persons realize," Dr. Perrine said, "that such a thing as mere lack of high frequency overtones could make a person unpopular and a failure."

State Payments to Aged, Blind, Children Told

SACRAMENTO, July 26 (U.P.)—Old age pensions were paid to 131,979 persons in California during the month of June, the department of social welfare revealed today. Total amount paid was \$4,282,347 and the average per person was \$32.45 for the month.


In Los Angeles county, 53,318 individuals received aid totalling \$1,720,688 an average of \$32.27 per month.

Aid to Blind
A total of 6,476 blind persons in California received aid amounting to \$311,035 during the month. The average per person payment was \$48.03, one cent more than the average for the preceding month.

In Los Angeles county, 12,239 persons received aid totalling \$225,203, an average of \$18.40 per person.

Children Benefited
Aid to needy children in the state totalled \$663,271 in June. The number of children receiving aid was 38,679 and the average payment to each child was \$17.15.

In Los Angeles county, 3,127 children received payments totalling \$150,549, averaging \$48.14 per child.

Coinage Rumors Harass Nations; U. S., British Mints Share Problems

WASHINGTON (U.P.)—U. S. all being accumulated in Scotland!

Treasury officials, just emerging from an avalanche of excited inquiries about the new Jefferson nickel, are finding solace in the knowledge that monetary officials of other countries have similar troublesome coinage problems.

The inquiries, which came in at the rate of more than 50 a day for nearly five months, concerned rumors that the treasury was planning to withdraw the new nickel from circulation.

One rumor was to the effect that because the nickels didn't fit slot machines they were being called in by the government. Another said that there was no flag above the "White House" on one side of the nickel, but that rumor was dissipated when it was explained by the treasury that Jefferson's home, "Monticello," and not the executive mansion was engraved on the coin.

The 68th annual report of the deputy master and comptroller of the royal mint of Great Britain, recently received at the treasury, disclosed a parallel situation.

"Popular interest was, and still is, focused upon the new type of threepenny piece," the report said. "Supplies of the new coin were first issued to the public in April, 1937, and its appearance in circulation was followed by a plentiful crop of rumors—not an unusual phenomenon where new official issues of any kind are concerned. Inquirers asked whether it was true that the issue was to be withdrawn and reminted because, as they had heard, a full stop had been used in the inscription instead of a colon; it was asserted that the issue had been made without legal authority and could therefore be refused as tender for a bus fare or what not; advice was sought whether the coins were valid for a silver collection or salutory in a Christmas pudding; we were warned that the cost of minting was in excess of the face value; and that they were

Terminal Island Home Port for 540 Vessels

Some idea of the size of the fleet of yachts, fishing boats and other small craft along Los Angeles County's ocean front is gained from figures in a report showing that Terminal Island alone is the home port of 540 of this kind of vessels having an assessed valuation of \$2,223,900.

The figures are contained in a report from the County Assessor's office, compiled at the request of Supervisor Oscar Hauge of the Fourth Supervisorial district.

The lists in the report include 194 fishing boats with an assessed valuation of \$1,253,915; 289 pleasure craft, assessed value, \$770,795; 57 miscellaneous vessels and barges with an assessed value of \$169,190, and four other vessels totalling \$2,030 in assessed valuation.
