NEW ORLEANS (U.P.)—Ten experts of the American novel sat down with a list of 59 nominations for the classic, and when they had finished. Nathaniel Hawthorne's "Scarlet Letter"—which gathers dust in the public libraries while more modern novels lengthen the waiting lists—had received eight of their votes. Judges, were staff members of the Newcomb College department of English and library and of Tulane University's library. "Moby Dick" and "Huckleberry Finn" tied for second and third places with six votes each. "House of Mirth." "House of Seven Gables," "Arrowsmith," "Monsieur Beaucaire" and "The Rise of Silas Lapham" received three votes each to complete the list. Books were given one vote every time they appeared on a list.
