### Lessing Named to Scout Post

### First Militarized Road Designated by Ohio

PARKMAN, O. (U.P.)—Ohio's first militarized road, 2.57 miles long, will pass through here. The project is a section of U. S. Route 422 and is designed as the first step in the militarization of the highway between the Mahoning Valley steel center at Youngstown and industrial Cleveland.

The route is one of the six major highways listed by State Highway Director Robert S. Beighler, who is a National Guard colonel, for permanent improvement as military roads. These are necessary not only for troop movements but for the transportation of essential war materials.
