OBITUARY

CHARLES G. RILEY

formerly operated a confectionery store at the corner of Torrance boulevard and Portola, since known as Alcorn's. Died at a Los Angeles hospital Saturday afternoon at age of 53 years. Had resided in Long Beach for 32 years and had been a shoe salesman for 20 years.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Marie Venable Riley; a daughter, Marjorie Ruth, at home; a son, Walter Glen Riley, Los Angeles; a brother, Fred Potsdam, N. Y., and a sister, Mrs. John C. Zow, Ashland, Ore.

Riley was a native of Potomac, Nov. 4, 1880. When she had completed her education she became a teacher, a profession she followed for 40 years. In 1918, with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Christopher Mowry, she came to California and taught in San Diego county schools until 1923 when she came to Torrance and was enrolled on the staff at the Torrance elementary school.

When the Fern Avenue school was established about ten years ago she was transferred to that institution and remained there until her failing health compelled her to leave the work she loved.

Miss Mowry is survived by three brothers, Guy L. Mowry of Palos Verdes Estates, John H. Mowry of New York, and Christopher Mowry of Vicksburg, Michigan; one sister, Mrs. Floy Bogart, of Wixom, Michigan.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the First Methodist church, of which she had been a devoted member. Rev. B. C. Brewster will have charge of the service, with Mrs. Phyllis Hamilton and Mrs. Helen Farnacht as soloists, Mrs. Finley, accompanist. Interment will be made at Inglewood Park cemetery.
