Testing laboratories were founded by the gas industry to provide a central agency for the testing of gas appliances ranges, water heaters, and house heating equipment—in order to insure uniform standards of safety, efficiency and structural quality.

According to W. H. Vogan, supervisor of Pacific Coast branch, 90 gas appliance manufacturers are now using the facilities of the laboratory, as compared with 75 four years ago. During the last year, 851 appliances and accessories were tested here. This represents the largest number ever to pass through the local branch, and is three times the volume of 1935.
