Concessions Show Wide Variety of Frolic Attractions

Everything from A (for archery) to Z (for zebra-hued hobby horses) will be available along El Prado in the way of Factory Frolic concessions.

These stands will be operated by and for local residents or organizations — no outside concessionaires being allowed to participate in this important feature of the second annual community celebration.

Many of the operators have kept their concession attractions secret until opening today so no summary can be given of what you can spend your nickels and dimes on during the week-end.

The children's ride attractions — merry-go-round, ferris wheel and others — of course had to be imported here from carnival operators but the Frolic committee has received guarantees of fair dealing, safe equipment and shares of the ticket sales to help defray the cost of the celebration.

A tour along El Prado today revealed that most of the stands are erected and stocked and already some are reporting brisk trade. The concessions will remain open at night until 11 or midnight.
