Mail Service Badly Hit Here by P. E.'s Move

ness executives here that a mail contract be given the bus firm as this would afford almost hourly service to and from Los Angeles.

"I have been advised that relief of the present situation would be given prompt attention and action as soon as possible," Postmaster Conner is telling those who have found fault with the restricted service here.

"The abandonment of P. E. lines through the county has created serious problems in the railroad

mail service and these are being investigated by postal officials in the area."

Letters dropped in the post-office after 5 p. m. and not "worked" to clear the office on the 5:46 mail train now do not leave Torrance until 6:05 a. m. the next day—too late for afternoon delivery in Los Angeles, it is reported. Industrial firms, particularly the Columbia Steel, National Supply and Rubbercraft, are hard hit by the curtailed service.

Their extensive correspondence throughout the southwest had received excellent mail service under the old schedule. Mail received at 11:27 was delivered to them by 12:30, affording time to answer queries and air-mail replies on the same day. This is not possible now. Under the present schedule, one eastern mail is received daily at the 2 p. m. mail is from the north.
