

EXPECT NO DELAY IN AGE CHECKS

Old age assistance checks to \$4,000 aged aid recipients in Los Angeles county for the month of February are being made up in advance in the expectation that \$1,600,000 of State and Federal money will be received by Feb. 1 to permit their mailing. County Auditor Joseph M. Lowery announced yesterday.

Release of this money to the county by the State Social Welfare Board is expected to be made by the State board on Jan. 29. At that time county supervisors will appear before the state board and report their capitulation to the demands of the board that they take agreements from aged not to encumber their property. County supervisors have voted to rescind their former action in refusing to require these agreements.

Matter Rests With State
Lowery's statement asserted that checks will be mailed out on time provided the State authorities speed the sending of State and Federal funds to this county. If the State authorities delay in sending this money to the county, Lowery will be compelled to withhold the checks until the money is actually received here.

Supervisors declare they have done all in their power to insure receipt by the aged of their February checks when due and that the entire matter now rests with the State authorities. They also advise the aged not to besiege their offices with inquiries regarding the matter as it is now beyond their control.

Additional workers to assist in the work of taking the agreements from the aged aid recipients have been authorized by the supervisors and this task is expected to be resumed immediately.

Request to Grade Avenue Is Filed

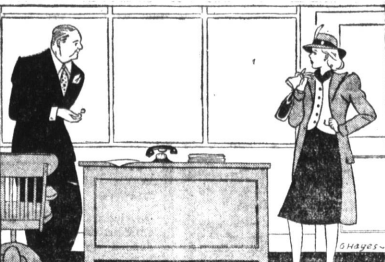
