JOINT MEET

A joint dinner and meeting of the realty boards of Torrance, Lomita, Redondo, Hermosa Beach and Manhattan Beach was held at the Hollywood Riviera Country club, Tuesday evening. Guest speaker was H. L. Gianetti, president of the California State Real Estate Association. He emphasized the work being carried on in Sacramento to reduce the tax burden being carried by property owners and assured his listeners that attempts to place additional tax burdens on property owners had been thwarted.

In pointing out a general improvement in real estate from the buying standpoint, he recalled the recent forecast of Roger Babson who stated that business for the first six months of 1940 would improve considerably over the same period for 1939 and, as a consequence, real estate would reflect a favorable increase in value correspondingly.

Miss Edith Smith, president of the Torrance-Lomita Realty Board, gave a brief but cheering message from her board, citing the efforts being made locally to improve the real estate situation for property owners and prospective owners here.

The meeting was attended by nearly all local real estate brokers and their salesmen.
