

SACRAMENTO, Cal. — California motorists burned almost 5,000,000 gallons of gasoline every day during the year, 1939, to set a new record for the use of motor vehicle fuel, the State Board of Equalization reported today.

The actual consumption of gasoline for the 12-month period amounted to 1,810,768,366 gallons, or 4,961,009 gallons each day, board records revealed. This


