

## "Public Notices"

City Clerk and all officials charged with the issuance of licenses to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance pertaining to the use of land or buildings for which any such license is required by any other Ordinance of the City.

It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police and all officers charged with the enforcement of the law to enforce this Ordinance and all the provisions of the same.

B. Any person, whether acting as principal, agent, employee or otherwise, violating any provisions of this Ordinance or of any variance and conditional permit granted hereunder shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail of the City of Torrance, or in the County Jail of the County of Los Angeles, at the discretion of the Committing Magistrate, for not to exceed three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Such person shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of this Ordinance is committed, continued or permitted by such person, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable as herein provided.

C. Any building or structure hereafter set up, erected, built, moved or maintained or any use of property hereafter contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby declared to be unlawful and a public nuisance and the City Attorney shall, upon order of the City Council, immediately commence action or actions, proceeding or proceedings for the abatement, removal and injunction thereof, in the manner provided by law and shall take such other steps and shall apply to such court or courts as may have jurisdiction to grant such relief as will abate or remove such building, structure or use and restrain and enjoin any person from setting up, erecting, building, moving or maintaining any such building, or structure or using any property contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance.

D. All remedies provided for herein shall be cumulative and not exclusive.

## SECTION 17. VALIDITY.

If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, sub-section, sentence, clause, and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, sub-sections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

## SECTION 18. REPEALING.

All ordinances of the City of Torrance inconsistent herewith to the extent of such inconsistency, and no further, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 19. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a weekly newspaper printed, published and circulated in the City of Torrance, and thirty (30) days after final passage thereof the same shall be in full force and effect.
