Legion Fireworks Show Will Have Impressive Acts

In order to make its Fourth of July Fireworks Spectacle and Circus this year the most complete ever presented, the American Legion has arranged for the appearance in the Coliseum that evening of the Four Jacks, sensational high-bar act which has been a feature attraction of the Golden Gate Exposition at San Francisco since its reopening.

Announcement of this was made this week by Commander John C. Dunn of the Los Angeles County Council of the Legion, under whose sponsorship the show will be presented for the eighth time in as many years. In direct charge of the spectacle is Harry Myers who is being assisted by Pat Lizza, fireworks expert, and Joe Bren, veteran circus man.

Workmen this week will begin the task of converting the Coliseum into a mammoth circus arena and fireworks stage, the latter requiring the use of the entire east end of the mammoth structure in front of the peristyle. As fully 30,000 seats will be thus rendered useless for the public, only 70,000 will be available for spectators. Tickets for these are now on sale at all Sontag Drug stores throughout the county and at Silverwood's Los Angeles stores where brisk demands are reported.

The spirit of Americanism will dominate the fireworks display, with the American flag forming the motif in many of the spectacular set pieces and red, white and blue fire predominating in the dazzling air effects. This spectacle represents the biggest single fireworks display to be presented anywhere in the country this year.

Community singing of American patriotic airs under the leadership of Hugo Kierhofer, an impressive flag-raising ceremony by the County Council's official color guard from Aqueduct Post aided by Post Eight's crack drum corps and many other features will make of the show this year the finest ever presented, states Commander Dunn.
