

Report Subversive Activities Only to F. B. I. Immediately

Donald Renshaw, state director for California for the Office of Government Reports, made the following announcement this week:

That it is the duty of every American citizen to report to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, all matters relating to espionage, sabotage, and "fifth column" activities. He pointed out, however, that care should be taken that the civil liberties of loyal and innocent individuals be not invaded and that care also should be taken to assure allens of complete and friendly protection under the law.

For this reason, Renshaw advises all citizens who have knowledge of subversive activities not to discuss the matter, or attempt to investigate, but to immediately inform their nearest Bureau of Investigation. This, Renshaw points out, is extremely important.
