American citizen to report to
the Federal Bureau of Investigation, all matters relating to

column" activities. He pointed
out, however, that care should
be taken that the civil liberties of loyal and innocent individuals be not invaded and
that care also should be taken
to assure aliens of complete
and friendly protection under
the law.
