Five Orange County South Coast areas, including the city of Laguna Beach, all of which have made application for annex attorn to the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California in order to secure urgently needed as supplies of Colorado River Aqueduct water, were notified Monday by the district board of directors that their applications will be given consideration.

In setting forth the terms under which these five South Coast areas may be accepted as parts of the MW.D., the board stated that it would first be necessary for these areas to organize themselves into one territorial unit of a type which legally may join the district. 
