HOLIDAYS are in the offing. And days that are not holidays are party days, club dance days, bridge days and guest days for cooler weather puts pep into people and places social obligations on the engagement records.

Here is a recipe for Holiday Nuggets — just the thing for busy snacks, before bed bites or refrigerator raids. You'll love them:

Holiday Nuggets
2½ cups sifted cake flour; ¼ teaspoon double-acting baking powder; ¼ teaspoon salt; ¼ teaspoon cinnamon; ¼ cup butter or other shortening; 2 eggs, well beaten; ¾ cup sugar; 1 teaspoon grated lemon rind; 1½ cups currants; 1½ cups walnut meats, coarsely cut.

Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder, salt, and cinnamon, and sift together three times. Cut in butter; add eggs, sugar, and lemon rind, and mix thoroughly. Add currants and nuts, mixing well. Drop from teaspoon onto greased baking sheet and bake in moderate oven (350° F.) 12 to 15 minutes. Makes 4 dozen nuggets.
