April 1 Is Deadline for Driving Licenses Issued Early in 1929

Motorists holding licenses issued during the months of January, February, and March, 1929, have only until April 1 to get them renewed.

Director of Motor Vehicles James Carter cancelled all these "good until revoked" licenses to weed out unfit and incompetent drivers. Another block of licenses will be outlawed between April 1 and August 14, 1929. In about a month.


