**Surprise Tarts**  
Broadcast by Mary Lee Taylor May 29, 1941

1 package vanilla pudding powder 1/2 teaspoon vanilla  
1 cup Fat Milk 1 cup drained apricots, cooked or diluted with 1 cup water  
Put pudding powder in saucpan. Gradually stir in diluted milk. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly. Continue stirring and cook slowly for 30 seconds. Remove from heat and stir in vanilla. Cover and cool 10 to 15 minutes. Put into baked Chocolate Pastry (See below). Chill until firm. Garnish with drained apricots. Serves 6.

**Chocolate Pastry**  
1/2 cups cake flour 1/2 teaspoon salt  
6 tablespoons cocoa 6 tablespoons cold shortening  
1 1/2 tablespoons sugar 6 tablespoons Fat powder

Turn on oven and set at moderately hot (300 F.). Sift flour before measuring. Beat with eggs, sugar, baking powder and salt. Work shortening into flour mixture with pastry blender, 2 knives or fork. When mixture is crumbly, gradually stir in milk. Divide dough into 6 portions. Roll each portion out on floured board into a round 1/2 inch thick and about 6 inches across. Line bottom and sides of 6 four-inch tart pans with pastry. Pinch pastry with fingers to make fancy edge. Prick bottom and sides of pastry with fork. Bake 15 minutes. or until pastry shrinks from sides of pans.  
\*To Substitute All-Purpose Flour for Cake Flour: Measure out the above amount of flour, then take out 3 tablespoons.
