TESTED RECIPES

Mary Lee Taylor's RADIO RECIPE



Ice Cream Surprise
Broadcast by Mary Lee Taylor June 26, 1944

1 1/2 cups Egg Milk, 1/4 cup cold water, 1 package vanilla ice cream powder, 1 teaspoon vanilla

Chill milk until icy cold. Meanwhile, put ice cream powder in bowl. Set in gradually a mixture of 1/4 cup chilled milk, water and vanilla. Chill thoroughly. Whip remaining 1 cup chilled milk with rotary egg beater, or electric beater at high speed, until stiff. Fold into chilled milk mixture. Freeze, without stirring, in mechanical refrigerator very at coldest temperature, or in a well insulated in a mixture of 3 parts crushed ice to 1 part ice cream salt. Serve in Corn Flake Nests (See below). Serves 6.

Corn Flake Nests

3 tablespoons butter, 6 tablespoons Egg Milk, 1 1/2 cups light brown sugar, lightly packed, 6 cups corn flakes

Melt butter in skillet. Add brown sugar. Cook slowly, stirring constantly until sugar is melted. Add milk and stir until smooth. Keep over very low heat while adding corn flakes. Turn gently over and over until all the corn flakes are coated with the milk mixture. Divide into 6 parts, putting each on waxed paper. With spoon and aid of fingers, shape into nests. Cool thoroughly. Fill centers with Vanilla Ice Cream (See above). Serves 6.
