ports that have been circulated to the effect that portions of the Court's cash books are missing. Rambo stated emphatically, "This is not true as I personally examined on July 5, 1941, all of the Court's cash books that were kept during the period Robert Lessing was City Judge, copies of which are on file in the City Clerk's office."

Politics Boomerangs
At a meeting of the City Council on May 27, Counciliana Powell, supported by Councilmen Murray and Babecck, ordered City Attorney McCall to start legal action to obtain from Lessing the sum of \$329 which Powell claimed "was: due the city for fines collected which are still due the city according to the auditor's report of May 13."
This report was compiled by the present City Auditor Logan Cotton, who was given the post a year ago, replacing Rambo, on motion of Babecck. It was upon Cotton's report, (based on what Rambo claims were "altered and raised figurés") that Powell and his recallee colleagues sought to file suit against Lessing. No mention of the legal action ordered against Lessing however, has been made at any of the various council sessions since May 27. In the light of the disclosures made this week by Rambo, it appears that the move against Lessing has developed into a political boomerang for Powell, Murray and Babecck, who are up for recall on July 29.
