RADIO RECIPE



Ribbon Sandwiches

Developed by Mary Lee Taylor August 14, 1941

2 cups shredded dried beef (7ozs) 1 1/2 teaspoons bottled mustard
2 1/2 tablespoons but 12 slices bread, white tea or other or whole wheat
shredding 24 strips American
2 tablespoons sour 1/2 cup fresh thick
1 cup Fat Milk

Cook dried beef slowly in butter until edges curl, stirring frequently. Sprinkle flour over dried beef and stir until blended. Stir in milk slowly. Boil 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat. Stir in mustard. Let stand. Turn on oven and set at moderately hot (400° F.). Remove crusts from bread. Toast bread on one side only. Cut each slice in half. Spread meat mixture on uncoasted side of bread, dividing equally. Put 1 strip of cheese on each sandwich. Place on shallow pan. Bake 5 minutes, or until cheese is slightly melted. Serve at once. Makes 2 dozen.

*If dried beef is very salty, rinse in boiling water and dry on towel before using.
