# **Wounded Youth** At Home: Brother **Awaits Probe**

Well on the road to complete recovery, Thurlow Weir, 17, who was wounded last Thursday by his 15-year-old brother, Jimmie, during an altereation at the family home, 1408 Acacia st., was discharged from Torrance Memorial hospital Tuesday. The 22-calibre builet fired by Jimmie at his brother was removed from the older boy's back by a surgeon.

Police have sent a complete report on the shooting to the County Juvenile Probation department, which is now conducting its own investigation to determine 'if Jimmie will be held for the Juvenile Court.

Thurlow was wounded at the climax of a bitter dispute and fight with Jimmie whom he accused of taking some of his money, according to Torrance police. Jimmie, after fighting with his brother in the house and duelling outside with garden tools, ran into the house again and locked the doors.

As Thurlow took off a window screen and began climbing thru, the younger boy took a 22 rifle off a wall, loaded it with a clip and ordered him back. Jimmie fired when Thurlow moved toward him. The boys live with their mother, Mrs. Lillian Weir, who at the time was at her place of employment on Terminal Island.
