Accidents During In Leadership Blackouts Told

Constituting a pressing public health problem during normal times, accident prevention is now one of major concern. It is the responsibility of the individual citizen to take such precautionary measures as may be necessary for avolding home accidents in the event of black-outs, County Health Officer Dr. W. L. Halverson, this week issued the following:

1. Your Civilian Defense Council recommends that only necessary electric lights be kept burning so that in the event of a blackout you can extinguish lights quickly. See that such lights are judiciously placed. It is not necessary to go groping around in semi-darkness unless a blackout has been declared.

2. See that your electric wiring is in good repair.
