California Leads in **Turkey Production**

A cash income of \$12,321,000 put California first in the nation for turkey raising, the federal-state crop reporting service announced this week. Texas was second with \$6,98,000, Minnesota with third with \$8,98,000, and Oregon fourth with \$5,98,000, and Oregon fourth with \$5,598, or the four states combined accounted for more than one-third of the total national turkey income last year of \$88,782,000, largest of record and 28 per cent above that of 1940.


