Formal approval to continuation of proceedings for the formation of County Improvement District No. 1076 for the improvement of 262nd street between Regent and Eshelman Aves., was given this week by the board of supervisors.

County Engineer Alfred Jones said that 45 days would be required to complete the improvement, which includes the construction of curbs, and he estimated the cost at \$2475. Length of the improvement will be about 600 feet.
