Hunters Must Use More Care In Mountains

California nimrods can tramp over the hills during the approaching seasons, but they'll have to be careful—more careful than ever before.

The state fish and game commission said today no restrictions will be placed on hunters, unless the federal government intercedes between now and the season's opening date.

The U. S. Forest Service already has closed Los Padres, August 1st. Those areas include Cleveland national forests to hunters because of the fire hazard.

The season opens in districts 17, 2, 2 1/2, 2 3/4 and 3 on August 1st. Those areas include counties along the coastal range.

Reports of deer in all state areas, especially those in northern California, say commission officials, are "very encouraging." Officials indicated deer are more numerous and well scattered this season than during the past several seasons.
