Foreign Trade **Zone Proposed** For L.A. Harbor

Advantages of a Foreign Trade Zone to serve Southern California, and to be located at Los Angeles-Long Beach harbor, were told to members of the Harbor, Foreign Commerce and Shipping Committee of the Los Angeles County Chamber of Commerce Tuesday by Thomas E. Lyons, Washington, D. C. executive secretary of the Foreign Trade Zones Board, U. S. Department of Commerce.

"Such a zone would give Southern California the one thing needed to make our harbor area second only in the United States to the Port of New York," Emerson Spear, chairman of the Chamber committee, said.

Lyons told the group that such a zone can be put in operation here within a few months. The only other free port zone in the United States now is in New York. It has been in operation since 1937 and handled a million dollars worth of merchandise its first year.

"A Foreign Trade Zone," Lyons explained, "is a walled-off.

"A Foreign Trade Zone." Lyons explained, "is a walled-off area with harbor and warehousing facilities over which the customs officials have no control. It is almost literally a little bit of 'homeland' for all foreign traders who desire to ship goods to the United States either for storage, for orderly marketing, or for re-export. Foreign goods coming into the zone are not subject to duty, and can be held for release when a market opens. Only when goods move into the American domestic market do they come under customs regulations."

The required form of address when the name of the prison amp is as follows:

Mail to prisoners or internees in a known locality where the name of the camp is not known should be addressed as follows:

(Formerly of Wake Island), Shanghal, China,
c'o Japanese Red Cross,
Tokyo, Japan.
In order to clear such correspondence through the Army censorship office the notation "Prisoners of War Correspondence" should be written in the upper left hand corner of the envelope, and at the bottom under the address "Via Chicago, Illinois" should be written In the upper right hand corner should be written the word "FREE".


