NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Education of the City of Los Angeles will receive bids for furnishing all labor and material for the following work:

Kind of Work and Name of School: ASPHALTIC CONCRETE YARD SURFACING AT TORRANCE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. Date of Bid Opening: September 29, 1942

Each bid shall be in accordance with drawings, specifications and other contract documents now on file in the Architectural Section of the Business Division of said Board, 1425 So. San Pedro street, Los Angeles, California.

Pursuant to the Labor Code of the State of California, the Board of Education has ascertained the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for each craft or type of workman needed to execute the contracts which will be awarded the successful bidders; and these prevailing rates are contained in said specifications adopted by the Board, and are as follows:

Table with columns: Classification, Hourly Wage, Overtime Rate, Rule. Rows include FOREMEN, APPRENTICES, CARPENTERS, CEMENT FINISHERS, IRON WORKERS, LABORERS, etc.

The rates of per diem wages of the various classifications of work shall be the hereinbefore set forth prevailing rates of hourly wages multiplied by eight (8). Eight (8) hours shall constitute a day's work.

The overtime rate establishing the rates of wages for overtime and holiday work for each of the various classifications shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

- A Double time for all overtime and holidays; B Time and one-half for overtime in excess of 8-hours in any one calendar day. Double time Saturday and Holidays; E Time and one-half for all overtime. Double time for all holidays.

Over time as herein referred to shall be deemed to be work performed in excess of eight consecutive hours per day, between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M., Monday through Friday, unless the job is operating on a shift basis.

Holidays as herein referred to shall be deemed to be every Sunday in the year except as otherwise provided herein, New Year's Day, Decoration Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Armistice Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

It shall be mandatory upon the contractor to whom a contract is awarded, and upon all subcontractors under him, to pay not less than said general prevailing rates of per diem wages to all workmen employed in the execution of the contract.

Notice is also hereby given that all bidders must submit with their bids, a sworn statement of their financial responsibility, technical ability and experience. Such sworn statement may be required to be furnished before award is made to any particular bidder.

Each bid shall be made out on forms to be obtained at said Architectural Section of the Board of Education; must be accompanied by a certificate or cashier's check or bidder's bond (issued by a Surety Company accredited by the Board of Education) for not less than Five Per Cent (5%) of the amount of the bid, made payable to the order of the Board of Education of the City of Los Angeles.

The successful bidders will be required to furnish labor and material bonds in an amount equal to 75% of the contract price, and faithful performance bonds in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price, said bonds to be secured by a surety company or surety companies satisfactory to the Board of Education.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and/or waive any informality on a bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening thereof.
