About Bandaging

Don't waste bandages, tape, edicines or any similar supplies. Don't even use them unless you know you are using tem correctly. An unbandaged ound—unless it's bleeding—can ait until the doctor arrives.

Don't apply adhesive tape, coton, fingers, ordinary cloth or oven gauze bandage directly to the wound. First place a sterile impress over the wound, then old it in place with tape or a andage. Don't band age too cosely—or everything will slip, ont bandage to ordipitly—or the velling will produce severe pain.
