


Deadline for initial inspection of tires and wheels of vehicles operated by gasoline rationed home-front motorists falls on Jan. 31, 1943. Required under the nationwide gasoline rationing regulations, the inspections, to be carried on by official inspection specially spaced throughout the coming year.
