A.—It is a simple form issued to the worker by his last employer or by a representative of the War Manpower Commission, approving the change of employment.

Q.—Is the decision of the W. M. C. representative final?

A.—No. The decision may be appealed to an appeals committee, and from there to the Area War Manpower Committee if necessary.
