CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 275 PROHIBITING PARKING OF MOTOR
VEHICLES IN PUBLIC
STREETS.
The City Council of the City
f Torrance does hereby ordain
s follows:

The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 275 of the City of Torrance is hereby amended by adding thereto another section to be known and designated as Section 3½ and reading as follows:

SECTION 3½. Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance, it is hereby declared unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park or stand in or upon any public street, court, drive, alley or other public places in the City of Torrance for more than forty-eight (48) consecutive hours within any period of seven days any motorcycle, automobile, trailer, camp car or any other motor or other type of vehicle owned, operated or controlled by such person, firm or corporation.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption and prior to expiration of fifteen (15) days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Torrance Heralca, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance, and thenceforth and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
