

Spring Rains Damage State Fruit Crops

Unseasonal spring rains have materially damaged prospects for large California fruit crops, a report of the California crop reporting service disclosed to-day. Grape and citrus crops, however, apparently escaped damage and average or better yields are expected, the service

said.

Especially light crops were forecast for almonds, peaches and apricots, with a warning that the apricot production may exceed only slightly the 103,000 ton short crop in 1940.

Better prospects were seen for apples, pears, plums and prunes. The cherry crop was estimated at 19,700 tons, more than 13,000 tons under last year's production.
