The fire hazards were not mentioned in Jofferv's letter to the council, which follows:
"The executive board of our union has had several discussions with your council on the subject of cover-up in the city-fire department. So far you have not agreed with the union's request that the city firemen be worked in accordance with the provision of City Ordinance No. 249, namely 24 hours on duty and 24 hours off, the off-duty period to be interrupted only in case of need. The practice now is that whenever there is an alarm at least one off-duty fireman must report to the station, whether

"We charge that (1) the Torrance city fire department is inadequately manned to provide proper protection to the citizens and property owners of Torrance.
