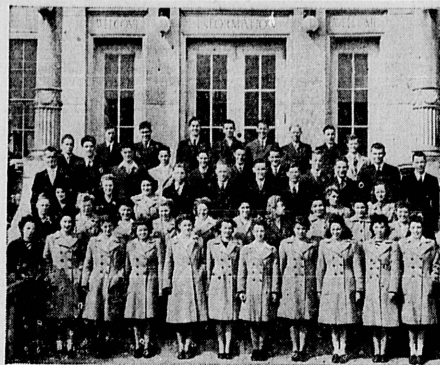
## Seven Points Must be Followed in Ration Application

- Seven major points to check off when filling out the application form for War Ration Book No. 3 were listed today by the O.P.A. Southern California applicants are advised to check them carefully, to avoid errors, which will result in delay in receiving the new book.
1. Print or type your name and return address in application form so it is easy to read.
  2. List name and birth dates of all members of family unit, related by marriage, blood or adoption, on the same application.
  3. Sign the application in your own handwriting.
  4. Tear off the identification stub, and keep it carefully. It is your receipt.
  5. Place 3-cent stamp on designated corner before mailing.
  6. Check application form carefully to avoid mistakes.
  7. Mail application before June 10.

## Nation's Most Unusual Graduating Class



THE 56 graduates of this year's class of the Moose child city of Mooseheart, Ill.—29 boys and 27 girls. They come from 20 states. Illinois leads with 13 graduates; Ohio and West Virginia second, with 6 each. At the commencement exercises to be held June 12, at Mooseheart, each graduate will be awarded a high school diploma accredited by the Illinois State Department of Public Instruction. In addition to an academic education, a Mooseheart graduate is trained in a useful trade or vocation, of which 22 are taught at Mooseheart. As of May 1, 1943, more than 400 Mooseheart graduates are now serving in the armed forces of the nation. The total number of graduates since the first class of 5 in 1919, including this class, is 1,646. This year Mooseheart celebrates the 30th anniversary of its founding by U. S. Senator James J. Davis of Pennsylvania, director general of the Loyal Order of Moose. In June, the 1,587 Moose lodges throughout the North American Continent will enroll classes totaling 25,000 candidates, as a feature of the celebration.

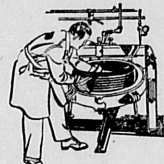

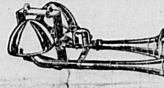
