Swimmers Warned Of Muscle Cramps; Treatment Given

The summer swimming season is the time to beware of muscle cramps, warns Dr. H. O. Swartout, chairman of the Health committee of the Los Angeles County Citizens Service Corps. If cramps come at all, they come so suddenly that there is no time to call for medical help. They are very painful, but not dangerous unless they come while their victim is in the water, where they may make him drown because he cannot move his arms or legs as he needs to do to keep on swimming.

But medical science can explain why cramps come; and this knowledge may help to prevent them, perhaps to save life. A muscle cramp is really a natural safety measure by which the body tries to prevent damage to the muscle from a shortage of nourishment while it is at work. The food for the muscle is brought to it by the blood. When a muscle is not accustomed to vigorous exercise the blood vessels that go to it become smaller. Then, if the muscle is suddenly forced to work harder than usual or if chilling shrinks the blood vessels, it can not get enough blood to nourish it; and a cramp comes to force the muscle to stop working.

Huge Increase In Stork Statistics

Births registered during the first six months of 1943 indicate an increase of 19.3 per cent over births registered during the same period of 1942, according to figures just made available by Robert G. Webster, registrar of the Los Angeles County Health department.

Webster pointed out that some of this increase is due to the gain in population of Los Angeles county, but a great deal of the increase is no doubt due to a rise in the birth rate, since similar but more moderate trends are indicated in other parts of the nation.
