Talent Academy To Open Branch

Of interest to local residents of all ages who wish to train for the stage, screen and radio is the announcement that the Pacific Talent Academy of Hollywood is opening a branch studio in Torrance at 1526 Cavens ave., in the hall adjacent to the Grand theater.

Entrance auditions will be given every Tuesday and Thursday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., beginning Sept. 14, according to J. H. Morris, manager of the academy. Courses in tap, acrobatic and ballet dancing, personality development, drama, voice and piano will be offered, in addition to cultural training for those who do not seek professional careers. There will be classes for all ages from tiny tots to adults, Morris states.

The Pacific Talent Academy has been training pupils in Hollywood for the past 16 years, and many of its pupils have qualified for contracts on the stage, screen and radio. "We are bringing to Torrance many of our finest instructors who have had years of experience in training Hollywood talent," Manager Morris said.
