

Pay of Deputy Sheriffs Hiked By Supervisors

The county board of supervisors has increased the pay of deputy sheriffs with the proviso that the officers' week be increased from 44 to 48 hours. Under this proposal these officers will receive \$195.50 instead of \$170 per month, an increase of 15 per cent. The new schedule will become effective Jan. 1.

Sheriff Eugene Biscailuz told board members that many deputies had gone to higher paid jobs on the Los Angeles police force and that the increase was necessary to maintain an adequate and efficient staff.

The board also voted \$5 monthly bonus to other county employees. Altogether the additional cost will amount to approximately \$400,000 per annum, Chairman Gordon L. McDonough stated.
