

Salvaged Kitchen Fats Q and A

The following questions and answers on the handling of salvaged kitchen fats in return for brown stamps, which started on Monday, Dec. 13, is released by the Office of Price Administration:

Q. When will brown stamps be given for salvaged kitchen fats?

A. This can be done now.

Q. How will they be paid?

A. Retailers will give the housewife one brown ration point for each half-pound of fats she brings in.

Q. Who may receive these stamps?

A. Only housewives, other consumers and operators of small boarding houses where fewer than 50 persons live.

Q. Who cannot receive brown stamps?

A. Restaurants, ships, manufacturing plants, retail meat dealers, eating establishments where more than 50 persons are fed, Army camps, post exchanges and all other similar establishments.

Q. Who will receive the 4 cents per pound for fats?

A. Everyone, just as before.

Q. The brown stamps were added to spur the housewives on to greater effort in saving fats.

Q. What about points for

fractional deliveries of fats?

A. Retailers will give the housewife one stamp for each half pound, and nothing for lesser fractions. For example, 1 pound 2 ounces would earn only two stamps the same as one pound.

Q. Is there any regulation how these brown stamps must be spent?

A. None, other than they shall be used just as brown stamps torn from the housewife's own book would have been.

Q. How will the retailer get these points?

A. He will give out brown stamps which he already has, or can secure an additional supply from his renderer. He need not register and his only records will be of the total pounds of grease he turns over to the collector or renderer.

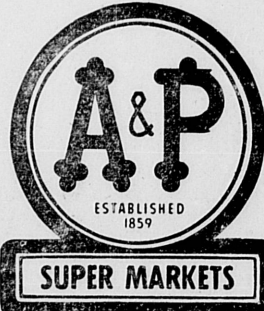
