ORDINANCE NO. 319 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 119 OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 119 is hereby amended by adding thereto sections 12d and 12e; Section 12d. The Chief of Police of the City of Torrance shall have the power and duty to place and maintain or cause to be placed or maintained official traffic control devices when and as required under any ordinance in force in the City of Torrance, and may place and maintain such additional traffic control devices as the City Council may direct by resolution, to regulate traffic under any ordinance in force in the City or under State law, or to guide or warn traffic, and to install traffic signals, safety zones and lanes for traffic.

Section 12e. The Chief of Police, when directed by resolution of the City Council, is hereby authorized:

1. To install and maintain official traffic signals at such intersections or other places described in any such resolution for the regulation of traffic.
2. To establish safety zones or unloading zones for the protection of pedestrians.
3. To make lanes for traffic on street pavements, consistent with the Vehicle Code and traffic ordinances of this City.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a weekly newspaper printed, published and circulated in the City of Torrance, and thirty (30) days after final passage thereof the same shall be in full force and effect.
