During 1941, the year before the United States entered the war, 5.049 felony cases were dis-posed of in superior court, while in 1942 this decreased to 4,822 and in 1943 to 4,313. The num-ber of superior court trials held for persons who pleaded not guilty on felony charges also dropped during the same period. In 1941, 1.330 trials were held; in 1942, 1,271, and in 1943, 1,770. Howser attributes the notice-able decrease in major crime among adults to: (1) The drawing off of mil-lions of young men of the age group in which most criminals are found into the armed forces. (2) The virtual elimination of unemployment by war indus-tions for the same period.
