The attorney general's office has issued a title for a proposed initiative constitutional amendment. The title is "Right of Employment," aimed primarily to outlaw the compulsory closed shop and guarantees right of employment, free from interference because an employe dies or does not belong to or pay money to a labor organization. To get a place on the November ballot the petition requires signatures of 178,764 qualified voters of the state by June 9, it was announced.


