The project, which will be undertaken by Southern Counties
Gas Company, Southern Coliforria Gas Company and the Padiffic Lighting Corporation, is expeeted to cost about \$4,000,000.

The Pacific Lighting Company

field, where an underground gas
storage operation of considerable magnitude has been in
progress for the past threeyears. The new pipelines, according to preliminary planssubmitted to WPB, will provide
a net increase of 164,000,000 cubic feet of gas for peak day
use by essential customers in
the Los Angeles area.

Walters, southern division manager of the Southern California Gas Company, will enable the gas companies in Southern California to store large volumes of surplus gas in the natural underground reservoir at La Goleta during the summer months when surplus gas is available and utilize this gas to meet peak loads in the winter-time.


