Rains Good for **County Crops**



County Crops

Rain at the end of April following a long dry period proved of great value to crops in Los Angeles county, according to a report on agricultural conditions made by Harold J. Ryan, agricultural commissioner. Particularly grain and vegetables on non-irrigated land were benefited.

Because of the dry spell citrus, avocado and deciduous or chards required irrigation a month earlier than usual. Growers of these crops feel that the late rain improved conditions materially.

Dry beans, an important crop in this county, are planted mostly in May. Much of the acreage devoted to this crop is on non-irrigated land and before the rain growers were fearful that there would not be sufficient moisture, to germinate the seed.

April was too cool to provide optimum conditions for vegetables that need hot weather. Growers in many instances have had difficulty in getting good stands of string beans, cantal loupes, cucumbers and sweet corn and these crops have grown slowly. On the other hand, vegetables such as spinach, lettuce and cauliflower that grow better in cool weather were of exceptionally good quality for the most part.
