The plan ambitiously tackles a structural phase of redevelopment by recommending "the eventual removal of virtually all structures between the shoreline pleasure drive and the sea, and subsequent redevelopment in conformity to the development plan." It advocates "the preparation of a plan to introduce, space through the removal of individual buildings, groups of buildings and full blocks based on a survey of the congested sections of the beach communities."
