# **County Budget Cuts Asked by** Citizens' Group

1. Reduce land purenases and capital expenditure projects by \$1,108,700;
2. Cut the unappropriated reserve by \$300,000;
3. Eliminate \$37,500 for the county band;
4. Revise estimate of revenue and surplus to reduce tax demand by at least \$200,000.

Pointing out that the \$91,107,474 budget for general county purposes for 1944-45, being considered by the board, includes expenditure proposals which will require a tax levy increase of \$1,700,000 and a tax rate increase of about 7 cents, based on 1943-44 assessed values, the committee said:

"The items listed above can be properly eliminated from the preliminary budget, without interference with the efficiency of county operations, so that the tax rate for 1944-45 need not exceed that of 1943-44."

Complimenting the board on its five successive years of tax rate reduction for Los Angeles county, the committee expressed appreciation of the careful consideration the board of supervisors has given to its recommendations for modifications in the county budget.
