Petroleum industry construction projects not exceeding \$100,000 now may be authorized by PAW. Previously this authority extended only to projects not exceeding \$25,000.
Deputy Petroleum Administrator Ralph K. Davies said, "Approximately 95 per cent of all construction project applications received from the petroleum industry are within the \$100,000 bracket. In the past industry construction project applications over \$25,000 when first approved by PAW were further reviewed and finally approved by the facilities bureau of W.P.E."

Torrance's civic pride may be expressed in the purchase of colorful uniforms for its home women's softball team.
Four members of the City Council have expressed willingness to purchase the uniforms, according to H. B. Dunn, Walteria merchant and team manager.
"Our long series of winnings over teams which have received more attention in Southern California merits the expenditure," Dunn told the councilmen.
Late inning batting rallies gave the Torrance Girls Softball team a double triumph in the past week and the heavy hitting is expected to continue Friday when the team goes to Anaheim to meet the unbeaten Buena Park girls' nine.
After spotting the Cannonettes a four-run lead here last Friday, the Torrance outfit came to life and pounded out a flock of base hits to win 5 to 4. Gene Kasperit started the fray on the hill but her control was missing and Myrtle Schubert had to finish.
Monday the team scored another triumph in the Long Beach girls' league, rallying in the eighth frame to wallop Douglas 11 to 6. It was the

final game of the second round in that circuit and gives Torrance a tie for second spot with L. A. Ship, Buena Park finished on top, remaining undefeated.
Betty Hicks, home run queen of the circuit, smashed a long hit to right field Monday to chase over three runs after Douglas had knotted the count in the seventh. Torrance was behind most of the way, due chiefly to fielding miscues, but came fast in the final innings when the chips were down.
Kasperit hurled the tilt with Schubert moving behind the bat to fill the vacancy in that spot caused by Martha McEmery's vacation absence.
Several new players will join the squad tomorrow in an at-string of the Buena Park team, according to H. B. Dunn, team sponsor.
